QUALITY	Purity of water is defined in part by the mineral content and is referred to as Total Dissolved Solids (TDS). TDS is directly related to the purity of water. The higher the TDS level in the water, the greater the probability of harmful contaminants that can pose health risks or hinder the absorption of water molecules on the cellular level.				
	The World Health Organisation (WHO) classify drinking water with a TDS of up to 300 mg/litre as good quality and 300 – 600 mg/litre as fair.				
	The Fine Water Society defines a waters subtle taste with the following TDS scale:				
	Super Low	0 – 50 mg/litre			
	Low	50 – 250 mg/litre			
	Medium	250 – 800 mg/litre			
	High	800 – 1,500 mg/litre
